

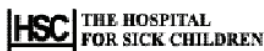

## Dr. Murray Arlin D.D.S., dip. Perio. F.R.C.D.(C)



Dr. Arlin received his D.D.S. at McGill University, his Diploma in Periodontics at the University of Toronto and his Fellowship in the Royal College of Dentists of Canada in 1983.

Dr. Arlin has taught at the University of Toronto at the undergraduate and post-graduate levels. He is past president of both the Ontario Society of Periodontists as well as the Ontario Study Club for Osseointegration

(OSCO) and was the chairman for the Canadian Academy of Periontology's full day Perio program. Dr. Arlin was a co-founder of the Toronto Implant Study Club, which was the largest private implant study club in Canada. He is also the founder of the Dental Hygienist Study Club of Toronto.

## Dr. Mark Nicolucci D.D.S., F.R.C.D.(C)



Dr. Nicolucci graduated from the University of Western Ontario Dental School, then attended a residency program at Temple University in Philadelphia. In 2010, Dr. Nicolucci graduated from Temple's Periodontology program with a certificate in Periodontology and Oral Implantology. In addition, Dr. Nicolucci received a Masters in Oral Biology, became a diplomat of the International Congress of Oral Implantology, and a Master of the Misch International Implant Institute.

Since returning to Canada he has been very active in lecturing and attending seminars both locally and internationally.
